We are currently processing your above-referenced application. Our preliminary engineering review reveals an issue with the antenna specifications as filed in the proposed construction permit as outlined in an e-mail sent to the contact representative on September 1, 2009, as shown below:

Mr. Petro, in lieu of sending a 30 day letter to the applicant and copy to you at this point in the processing of the above referenced application, I am contacting you by e-mail to have the applicant clear up the issue with the antenna that is indicated in the modification application.

On Question 9a of the 301-CA application the applicant has selected Directional Composite as the type of antenna used which would have relative field values and would be required to be filed as part of the application. IN Question 9c of the form the applicant selected N/A Non directional or Directional "Off-the-Shelf" This selection is incorrect unless the applicant has selected one of the following two under 9a Nondirectional Directional "Off-the-Shelf".

Please have the applicant verify the correct type of antenna he is proposing to use and amended the application accordingly.

Secondly, and for your information and the applicants, the licensee indicates in his attachment that the proposed facility requests operation based on employing a Full Service Out-Of-Channel Emission Mask. As instructed by Video Management effective September 1, 2009, we are not accepting or using full service emission mask as part of our engineering analysis until it has become part of our technical rules; therefore, when we receive the amended information for the antenna, we will be performing our analysis based on the type of mask indicated in the proposed application.
