Greetings Mohammad,

We spoke a couple of weeks ago about a potential problem with an incumbent licensee possibly interfering with our STA grant on channel 31 in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Our engineer used a spectrum analyzer to determine that there is indeed a digital signal being broadcast on the same channel for which you just granted our STA request. The offending station appears to be WPXD, see http://licensing.fcc.gov/cgi-bin/ws.exe/prod/cdbs/pubacc/prod/sta_det.pl?Facility_id=5800. They have a CP for channel 50, but it appears that they have not relinquished the use of channel 31 yet. Can you please help us figure out if WPXD is still authorized to be on the air, and if they are, I'm curious as to why this wasn't caught prior to grant of our STA?

If WPXD is still authorized to be on the air on ch 31, will we still have to pay new filing fees if we request a replacement channel for our STA? We have identified channel 26 as being available for licensing at that location.
