Dear Applicant:

By letter dated May 27, 2010, the staff dismissed the above-referenced application for a construction permit for a new digital low power television station on channel 46 at Wenatchee, Washington. The application was dismissed because Iglesia Pentecostal Visperia Del Fin ("Iglesia") had failed to respond to an earlier deficiency letter requesting that the application be amended to resolve predicted interference to another station.

Iglesia filed a timely petition for reconsideration stating that it has no record of having received the deficiency letter. In addition, it states that the staff failed to send a copy of the letter to its counsel, who is designated as the "Contact Representative" in the application. Iglesia also proffers a technical amendment which it believes will resolve the predicted interference. In view of the foregoing, the petition for reconsideration filed by Iglesia Pentecostal Visperia Del Fin IS GRANTED and the application IS REINSTATED for further processing.
