**Subject:** FanVision Rqst for STA - Fontana, CA - Change Frequency

Greetings Mohammad,

As per our telephone conversations this morning, we request a change in frequency for FanVision Entertainment, LLC's request for STA to operate in Fontana, CA. The original request listed 46 as the frequency; we would like that changed to channel **44**. Everything else in the STA request will remain unchanged.

The reason for this request is that on Wednesday, January 4, I received a phone call from Howard Fine, who identified himself as the "Broadcast Coordinator for LA". Mr. Fine stated that FanVision's request for STA would cause interference to an existing LA area LPTV broadcaster on channel 46. We stated that the channel requested was reviewed and accepted by both our consulting engineer, Mel Freedman, and the Video Services Division of the FCC.

Further correspondence between Mr. Freedman and Mr. Fine led to an understanding that the FCC regulations only require that our STA request protect an incumbent LPTV to their 51 dBu contour, but Mr. Fine wants us to protect the LPTV incumbent's 41 dBu contour. Mr. Fine has requested that FanVision utilize channel 44 for the STA instead of channel 46.
