
FanVision Entertainment LLC ("FanVision") recently requested Special Temporary Authority to operate Low Power Television Stations on various UHF channels at the above listed locations. As an addendum to those requests, FanVision respectfully submits the following:

The antennas to be used in the broadcasts associated with the aforementioned STA requests will increase the overall height of the buildings to which they are attached by less than six (6) meters, thus negating any requirements for notifying, or coordinating with, the FAA. In addition to FanVision's compliance with the 6.10-meter Rule criteria, please note that each venue where the above listed broadcasts will take place has tall buildings and light poles on the premises which far exceed the height of the top of the broadcast antennas here at issue.
