Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for K259BK, Seward, Alaska.

An engineering study of the application reveals that it is in violation of 47 C.F.R. § 74.1231(b). Section 74.1231(b) of the Commission's Rules states that a noncommercial educational FM translator station that is operating on a reserved channel (Channels 201-220) and is owned and operated by the licensee of the primary station it rebroadcasts may use alternative signal delivery means.

The translator proposes to rebroadcast primary station WJSO (BMLED-20031106AGD) on channel 206 and deliver the signal via an alternative method. The licensee of WJSO(FM) is The Moody Bible Institute of Chicago which is not the licensee of the translator. The application failed to discuss this violation.

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20101129AAK filed by Turquoise Broadcasting Company, LLC is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
