Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to station WOOT-LP and its unbuilt digital companion channel facility, WOOT-LD, Chattanooga, Tennessee, licensed to Digital Networks-Southeast, LLC. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that WOOT-LP has been silent since November 2, 2011² and that WOOT-LD has not been constructed. Accordingly, the license for WOOT-LP and construction permit for WOOT-LD ARE HEREBY CANCELLED and the call signs ARE DELETED. In addition, the above-referenced request for silent authority and an engineering STA ARE HEREBY DISMISSED. Finally, because we are cancelling the license, the inquiry made in Division letters dated March 24, 2011 and April 12, 2012 regarding the station's failure to file FCC Form 398 Children's Television Programming Reports since the second quarter of 2007 is closed.
