Dear Licensee:

By letter dated December 5, 2012, the staff cancelled the license, deleted the call sign and dismissed the above-referenced STA requests for Class A television station WOOT-LP and its unbuilt digital companion channel facility, WOOT-LD, Chattanooga, Tennessee. The staff did so pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act,¹ believing that the station had been silent since November 2, 2011. Digital Networks-Southeast, LLC (Digital) filed a timely petition for reconsideration, stating that it began digital operations on January 17, 2012 and so was not silent for more than one year. In addition, Digital submitted a letter dated January 2, 2013, requesting that the station's status be changed from Class A television to low power television.

In view of the foregoing, the petition for reconsideration IS GRANTED, the license for WOOT-LP and construction permit for WOOT-LD ARE HEREBY REINSTATED and the above-referenced engineering STA request (BSTA-20121012AAB) IS GRANTED. In addition, as requested by Digital, the status of WOOT-LP has been changed to low power television.² Because Digital asked that the station revert to low power television status, the inquiry made in the Division letters dated March 24, 2011 and April 12, 2012 regarding the station's failure to file FCC Form 398 Children's Television Programming Reports since the second quarter of 2007 is closed.
