This is with respect to the five above-referenced TV translator stations licensed to Pikes Peak Television, Inc. (PPTV). On March 18, 2014, the staff cancelled the licenses because PPTV had failed to file renewal applications by the filing deadline for television stations located in Colorado. PPTV filed a timely petition for reconsideration for the five TV translator stations, which rebroadcast the ABC network programming of KRDO-TV, Colorado Springs, Colorado. PPTV also filed requests for special temporary authority to continue to operate the stations and renewal applications.

For the reasons set forth in the petition for reconsideration, the licenses for the above-referenced TV translator stations licensed to Pikes Peak Television, Inc. are **HEREBY REINSTATED**.
