Dear Licensee:

On March 7, 2012, the Video Division issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* to the Licensee regarding violations at the above-captioned stations.<sup>1</sup> The Video Division issued a *Forfeiture Order* on May 23, 2013<sup>2</sup> and a *Memorandum Opinion and Order* denying reconsideration on March 31, 2014.<sup>3</sup> The *Memorandum Opinion and Order* informed the Licensee that, if it elected to revert W15AZ or W49AY to low power status, the Licensee would no longer be liable for the forfeiture amount described.<sup>4</sup>

In an April 22, 2014 letter, the Licensee requested that Station W15AZ be reclassified to low power status. By this letter, we confirm that Station W15AZ has been reverted to low power status. We further confirm that the May 23, 2013 *Forfeiture Order* against Stations W15AZ and W49AY is hereby RESCINDED. Please be informed that no further action is required of the Licensee.
