
The staff has under consideration the above captioned application for a new low power FM station to serve Edmonds, WA and the March 12, 2014 Informal Objection filed by Seattle FCC License Sub, LLC (“SFL”).

On March 12, 2014, SFL filed an Informal Objection stating that MCF’s proposed facility has not received reasonable assurance to use the proposed antennas tower site. SFL also claims that MCF improperly answered “Yes” to question 8a in section VI of the application and although providing a second adjacent waiver showing, did not specifically request a second adjacent short spacing waiver.

To date, there has been no response from MCF regarding the claims made by SFL. The staff requires additional information from MCF regarding these allegations before it can complete processing of the application.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to submit the requested information. Failure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1).
