
Dear Sirs and Madams:

On March 21, 2012, the FCC issued to CASA of Corpus Christi, L.P. ("CASA-CC"), licensee of Class A television station KXCC-CA, Corpus Christi, Texas (Fac. ID 48834) (the "Station"), an Order to Show Cause (DA 12-431) why its authorization should not be modified to specify the station as a low power television station. CASA-CC responded to the Order to Show Cause on April 27, 2012. On March 23, 2012, the FCC also issued to CASA of Austin, L.P. ("CASA-CA"), licensee of Class A television station KXCC-CA, Corpus Christi, Texas (Fac. ID 48834) (the "Station"), an Order to Show Cause (DA 12-439) why its authorization should not be modified to specify the station as a low power television station. CASA-CA responded to the Order to Show Cause on April 27, 2012.

By this letter, following and pursuant to discussions with the FCC staff regarding the unresolved Order to Show Cause, Renewal Application and Assignment Application, CASA-CC hereby agrees, pursuant to Section 73.6001(d) of the FCC's rules, to voluntarily downgrade Station KXCC-CA from a Class A station to low power television station. Pursuant to those discussions, it is our understanding that the FCC also will simultaneously dismiss the Order to Show Cause against KXLK-CA, thereby leaving the KXLK-CA Class A status intact.
