Dear Licensees and Counsel:

This is with respect to station KXCC-CA, Corpus Christi, Texas, and KXLK-CA, Austin, Texas, which are licensed to CASA of Corpus Christi, L.P. (CASA-CC) and CASA of Austin, L.P. (CASA-Austin), respectively. Both stations are currently licensed as Class A television stations, and are, therefore, accorded primary spectrum use status pursuant to the Community Broadcasters Protection Act of 1999 (CBPA).¹ Section 73.6001(c) of the Commission's rules provides primary spectrum use status as long as the minimum operating requirements for Class A stations are met.² Pursuant to subsection (d), if a licensee is unable to continue to meet the minimum operating requirements for Class A television stations, or otherwise elects to revert to low power television status, it shall promptly notify the Commission, in writing, and request a change in status. Section 316(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, also permits the Commission to modify an authorization if such action is in the public interest.³ This procedure is set forth in Section 1.87 of the Commission's Rules.⁴

On March 21, 2012, we issued an *Order to Show Cause* requiring CASA-CC,⁵ to explain why the authorization for KXCC-CA should not be modified to specify the station as a low power television station.⁶ We issued a separate *Order to Show Cause* on March 23, 2012 requiring CASA-Austin⁷ to explain why its authorization for KXLK-CA should not be modified to specify the station as a low power television station.⁸ On April 27, 2012, CASA-CC and CASA-Austin filed responses to the *Orders to Show Cause*.

On April 20, 2015, CASA-CC filed a letter requesting a change in station status for KXCC-CA from Class A to low power pursuant to Section 73.6001 of the Commission's Rules.⁹ We granted this request on April 21, 2015. After a review of the record before us, we find that, pursuant to section 316(a) of the Act, changing the status for station KXLK-CA would not serve the public interest. We, therefore, terminate both the *KXCC-CA Reclassification Proceeding* and the *KXLK-CA Reclassification Proceeding*.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Sections 4(i), 316, and 332(f)(2)(A)(ii) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 316, 332(f)(2)(A)(ii), and Section 1.87 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.87, that the *KXCC-CA Reclassification Proceeding* IS TERMINATED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *KXLK-CA Reclassification Proceeding* IS TERMINATED.
