Dear Counsel:

By letter dated April 17, 2014, the Video Division granted the above-referenced application of PMCM TV, LLC ("PMCM") for a construction permit for WLJP (formerly KVVN(TV)), RF channel 3, Middletown Township, New Jersey, and dismissed as premature the Informal Objection filed by Meredith Corporation ("Meredith"), licensee of WFSB(TV), Hartford, Connecticut, objecting to PMCM's future use of virtual channel 3 in the Program System and Information Protocol ("PSIP") portion of WLJP's broadcast television signal. Meredith filed a joint Petition for Reconsideration and Request for Declaratory Ruling. In the reconsideration portion of its pleading, Meredith argues that the Division erred in holding that it was premature to consider WLJP's virtual channel assignment at the pre-construction phase. In its Request for Declaratory Ruling, it argues that WLJP should be required to use channel 33 as its virtual channel, rather than channel 3.

On June 5, 2015, the Media Bureau released a Declaratory Ruling granting, *inter alia*, Meredith's Request and ordering PMCM to operate WLJP using virtual channel 33.¹ In light of this ruling, Meredith's Petition for Reconsideration of the timing of a Commission ruling of the appropriate virtual channel for WLJP is moot. Accordingly, Meredith Corporation's Petition for Reconsideration of grant of the above-referenced application for a construction permit IS DISMISSED.
