Dear Mr. Henderson:

This letter is in reference to: (1) WCUZ's above-captioned minor change application to modify the class, channel, effective radiated power, and antenna height; (2) WOUF's above-captioned minor change application, as last amended on October 15, 2014, to modify effective radiated power, antenna height, and transmitter site; (3) KNRG's above-captioned minor change application, as amended on December 8, 2014, to modify the class, effective radiated power, antenna height, and transmitter site.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1910, the Commission examines applications to determine if the applicant is delinquent in any non-tax debt owed to the Commission.¹ This letter is to notify you that the applicant is delinquent on the payment of debts owed to the Federal Communications Commission. For the purpose of determining if an applicant is delinquent the Commission checks the status of all entities with whom an applicant shares the same tax payer identification number.

Further action on the subject applications will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to resolve this debt. Failure to respond within this time period and to resolve this debt will result in the dismissal of the applications for failure to prosecute pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Sections 0.283, 1.1910(b)(3) and 73.3568(a)(1).
