STANDARD BROADCAST STATION LICENSE
MODIFICATION

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ^{1/}the LICENSEE

WILLIAM HOWARD COLE

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time JUNE 1, 1982

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

- On a frequency of 1490 kHz.
- With nominal power of .25 kilowatts nighttime and 1.0 kilowatts daytime, with antenna input power of 235 watts nondirectional Antenna current 2.05 amperes antenna nighttime Antenna resistance 56 ohms, and antenna input power of 940 watts nondirectional Antenna current 4.1 amperes antenna daytime Antenna resistance 56 ohms

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
