Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Peltzman:

This letter concerns the request you filed on November 21, 2016, on behalf of Armida A. Saille (Saille), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Translator Station K283CJ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that Saille stated that Station K283CJ went silent on May 16, 2016, because it lost its programming source. The previous STA was granted on May 24, 2016, and expired on November 20, 2016. Saille requests extension of its STA while it continues searching for a new programming source. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Saille's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K283CJ to remain silent until May 16, 2017. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K283CJ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., May 17, 2017.**<sup>1</sup>

Saille is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If Saille does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
