To Whom It May Concern:

The State of Florida, through its Department of Transportation (FDOT), is the licensee of Low Power FM stations WFLP-LP and WFLU-LP. Cellular communications and Internet services are now available through this part of the Everglades and are regularly accessed for travel information. FDOT's supplemental travel information low power FM broadcasting is no longer required for safe transit of motorists through the Everglades, and the State of Florida wishes to discontinue the services provided by WFLP-LP and WFLU-LP. With this letter it surrenders the attached licenses and grants of renewal for the above stations.

WFLP-LP, Facility ID 134910, License File No. BLL-20031121AGU, Permit no. BNPL-20010614AGN, provides service from Collier County Rest Area, in the median of I-75 and approximately halfway between Naples Fort and Lauderdale, Florida. When it was installed, it was a crucial communications link in providing road-related information to motorists transiting I-75 between the two cities, and one of the very few information sources motorists could find between the cities in the event of traffic blockages or stoppages. Educational programming about the Everglades is provided to the audience when emergency routing and traffic information is not being broadcast.

WFLU-LP, Facility ID 134872, License File No. BLL20031121AHQ, Permit no. BNPL-20010614AGM, provides the same service from a location near the interchange of I-75 and State Route 29, covering a Western exit from the Everglades crossing route. Programming identical to that of WFLP-LP is broadcast from WFLU-LP.

The license documents posted in the broadcast transmitter shelters are enclosed for surrender.
