Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Koerner:

This letter concerns the request you filed on January 12, 2017, on behalf of Jesus Pena Acosta (JPA), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Radio Station KJJT to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that JPA stated that Station KJJT(FM) went silent on May 5, 2016, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on July 14, 2016, and expired on January 10, 2017. JPA requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

JPA's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KJJT(FM) to remain silent until May 1, 2017. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KJJT(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., May 2, 2017.**¹

JPA is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If JPA does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
