Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ^{1/}the LICENSEE

KFRA, INC.

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time JUNE 1, 1989

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

- On a frequency of 1390 kHz.
- With nominal power of - watts nighttime and 500 watts daytime,
with antenna input power of - watts - directional [- current - amperes
antenna nighttime [- resistance - ohms,
and antenna input power of 500 watts non directional [Antenna current 1.3 amperes
antenna daytime [Antenna resistance 300 ohms

Antenna and ground system: 325' (328' overall height) uniform cross section, guyed, shunt excited (folded unipole) vertical radiator. Ground system consists of 120 equally spaced, buried, copper radials 175' in length plus the remains of a similar ground system formerly used directional antenna operation. Antenna efficiency is restricted to 190 mv/m/kw.

The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
