EMERGENCY INTERFERENCE COMPLAINT

3B Properties, Inc., ("3B"), licensee of Radio Station WIHG(FM), Rockwood,
Tennessee, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.1203, hereby respectfully submits this Emergency
Interference Complaint against the above-captioned FM Translator Station, which is causing
extensive harmful interference to listeners' reception of 3B's full power FM station, WIHG(FM)
Rockwood, TN (Facility ID 5113) assigned on FM Channel 289C3.

Hodges Media, LLC (HML) is currently licensed to operate W289CU pursuant to FCC License BLFT-20181004ABC. W289CU is currently rebroadcasting WKGN(AM) Knoxville, Tennessee (facility ID 68146).

Pursuant to Section 74.1203, W289CU must immediately cease operations until all complaints of interference can be resolved. Furthermore, unless the interference complaints can be resolved, the license for W289CU must be revoked because its status as a secondary service is required to protect the reception of authorized full power broadcast stations such as WIHG.

3B is the licensee of full power FM radio station WIHG (Facility ID 51113) which operates on Channel 289 as a Class C3 FM facility licensed to Rockwood, Tennessee. Rockwood is part of the Nielsen Rated Knoxville, Tennessee "Total Survey Area" and radio station WIHG has regular "over the air" listeners in Knox County, Tennessee and within the City of Knoxville which are both rated as part of the Knoxville "Metro" Nielsen Rated Radio Market. The interference being generated by the W289CU translator operation is causing an economic hardship on 3B because of the dramatic loss of listenership and coverage area and thus the request for expedited emergency processing from the Commission staff.

Because the center of radiation above mean sea level of the licensed WIHG transmitter site on the Cumberland Plateau is 835 meters (2,740 feet) and the lack of intervening terrain between the tower site and Knoxville (the W289CU radiation center above mean sea level is only 359 meters or 1,178 feet), WIHG places a very listenable over the air signal over much of the City of Knoxville and the entire Southwestern portions of Knox County. The station has consistently had ratings in Knox County over the past 13 years.

Based upon listener complaints, it appears the facility authorized to HML in its construction permit application BNPFT-20180606AAA, commenced operation on Channel 289 (the same channel as WIHG) sometime on or around October 11, 2018. Since that time, 3B has received numerous reports of interference in and around areas of the Knoxville metro area including Cedar Bluff, Farragut, Kingston Pike, Turkey Creek, Campbell Station, Oak Ridge, Solway, Pellissippi Parkway and Farragut. Additionally, major traffic thru ways have been affected including Interstates 40 and 140, US Highway 70 and Highway 62.

According the statements from WIHG listeners attached hereto, the WIHG signal has been replaced over much of the area by a station programming Fox Sports. WKGN(AM) is the only

station in the area calling themselves Fox Sports and the WKGN call letters can be clearly heard on channel 289. These complaints are *prima facie* evidence that the operations of W289CU are causing impaired reception to the regularly used signal of WIHG.

Section 73.1203 (a) of the Commission's Rules provides in pertinent part that "An authorized FM translator or Booster Station will not be permitted to continue to operate if it causes any actual interference to: (1) The transmission of any authorized broadcast station: or ...(3) The direct reception by the public of the off-the-air signals of any authorized broadcast station... Interference will be considered to occur whenever reception of a regularly used signal is impaired by the signals radiated by the FM translator or booster station, regardless of the quality of such reception, the strength of the signal so used, or the channel on which the protected signal is transmitted."

Since 3B has demonstrated that interference is occurring to the reception of WIHG, 3B requests that the Commission immediately order HML to suspend operations of FM translator station W289CU and order it cease broadcasting immediately until all interference complaints can be mitigated.

Comments: Listens to 105.7 The HOG/WIHG as he travels daily to and from work at Clayton Homes of Maryville. He reports receiving interference from Fox Sports Radio (WKGN) beginning along Pellissippi Parkway at Hardin Valley Rd and becomes progressively worse until Fox Sports completely shuts WIHG out as he crosses I40 on to I140. He used to be able to listen to 105.7 The HOG/WIHG out I140 to his work in Maryville, but because of interference from the Fox Sports 105.7 translator signal he can no longer listen to 105.7 The HOG/WIHG. Mr. Marino also stated he attempted to contact WKGN but received no response.

She reports interference from Fox Sports Radio (WKGN) begins at the I40/I75 Split and continues until she passes Pellissippi Parkway and Fox Sports completely shuts WIHG out. She could always hear 105.7 The HOG/WIHG along I40 when she exited on Cedar Bluff Road, traveling to Kingston Pike, then to her work at the corner of Rocky Hill and Northshore. Since WKGN commenced operation on October 11th, she can no longer listen to 105.7 The HOG/WIHG.
