Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 5, 2019. CCL requests an extension of the STA granted on February 21, 2018, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application based upon repairs done over the past year.¹ In support of the request, CCL states that additional time is needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ KCSJ(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 590 kHz with 1 kW day and night, using different patterns.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CCL may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power if needed. CCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **September 19, 2019**.
