Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to: (1) conduct telemetry, tracking, and command operations necessary to drift the Intelsat 805 space station from the 169.0° E.L. orbital position to the 169.1° E.L. orbital location, and to maintain it at this location using the following center frequencies: 6173.7 MHz, 6176.3 MHz, 12198.75 MHz (Earth-to-space), 3947.5 MHz, 3948.0 MHz, 3950 MHz and 3952.0 MHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands; and (2) provide fixed-satellite service via Intelsat 805 in the 5850-6650 MHz, 14000-14250 MHz (Earth-to-space), 3400-4200 MHz and 12500-12750 MHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands once located at the 169.1° E.L. orbital location.
