Modification

SES Americom, Inc. requests modification of its license for its direct to home fixed satellite and fixed satellite service satellite AMC-15, to continue to operate AMC-15 at 105.05 W.L. through October 1, 2026 and authority permitting SES to reorient the satellite to provide coverage to North America, the Caribbean, and Central America. AMC-15 will continue to conduct operations in the 11.7-12.2 GHz, 18.6-18.8 GHz, and 19.7-20.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands and the 14.0-14.5 GHz, 28.4-28.6 GHz, and 29.5-30.0 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. AMC-15 will also continue to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command on the following center frequencies: 11702.0 MHz, 12198.0 MHz, and 18582.0 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 14001.5 MHz (Earth-to-space).
