Dear Ms. Dortch:

SES Americom, Inc. ("SES"), by its attorney, hereby advises the Commission that it has placed its AMC-5 spacecraft, call sign S2156, into a disposal orbit and asks that the Commission close the IBFS license account for this spacecraft.

Deorbit maneuvers commenced on May 6, 2014, and final commands were sent on May 17, 2014. The disposal orbit has a perigee altitude of approximately 241 km above the geostationary arc and an apogee altitude of approximately 292 km above the geostationary arc. The eccentricity is approximately 0.0006.

In light of the satellite's retirement, SES requests that the Commission terminate the license account for call sign S2156 in the IBFS database.
