**ILLEGAL RADIATE POWER OPERATION**

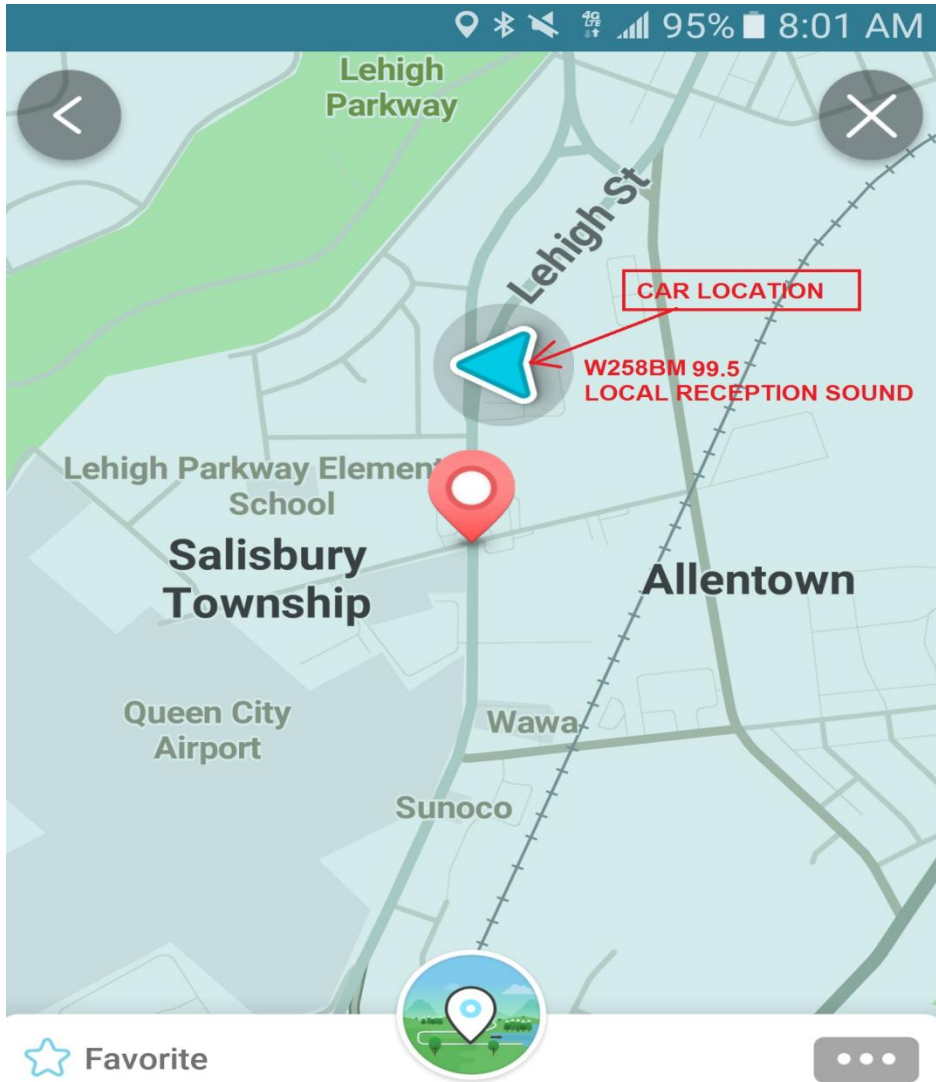
Radio Sharon Broadcasting, LLC. (Sharon) has under lease agreements, the following stations: WLEV HD3, W221CU 92.1 FM Allentown, PA. and W258BM 99.5 FM Easton, PA.

According to these agreements Sharon will start to program those stations by July 15<sup>th</sup>. When WLEV HD3 Channel will be ready to program. Sharon pursuant to Commission's rules, hereby submits this Complaint to the above-captioned Station by WHOL RADIO INC. the power to cover of FM translator W258BM, Easton, PA. Should be investigate since it's presumable 4watts does not reach Allentown City, But Sharon has ran an exploration with radio apparatus and determinate that this FM Translator has an excellent audible local signal for Allentown City violating the rules because is known that 4 watts at 4105 Sherry Hill Rd Lower Saucon Twp, PA over 20 miles from Allentown should be a weak signal.

Since Radio Sharon Broadcasting is operating under lease W221CU 92.1 FM in Spanish Programming for Allentown City is considering an unfair competition from W258BM to be operating with more than 4 watts and is crystal clear heard at Allentown City.

Sharon is providing attachments on this documentation Pictures, and has Audio & Videos obtained from different locations where W258BM can be heard in Allentown and some other cities where W258BM is not supposed to be heard locally making illegal competition and consequently violating the

rules of FCC when broadcast with more power than permitted. These videos and audio are upon to request since attachments are too big in megabits This Picture was captured on Lehigh Street. Allentown where Sharon's Vehicle was running exploring this violation.

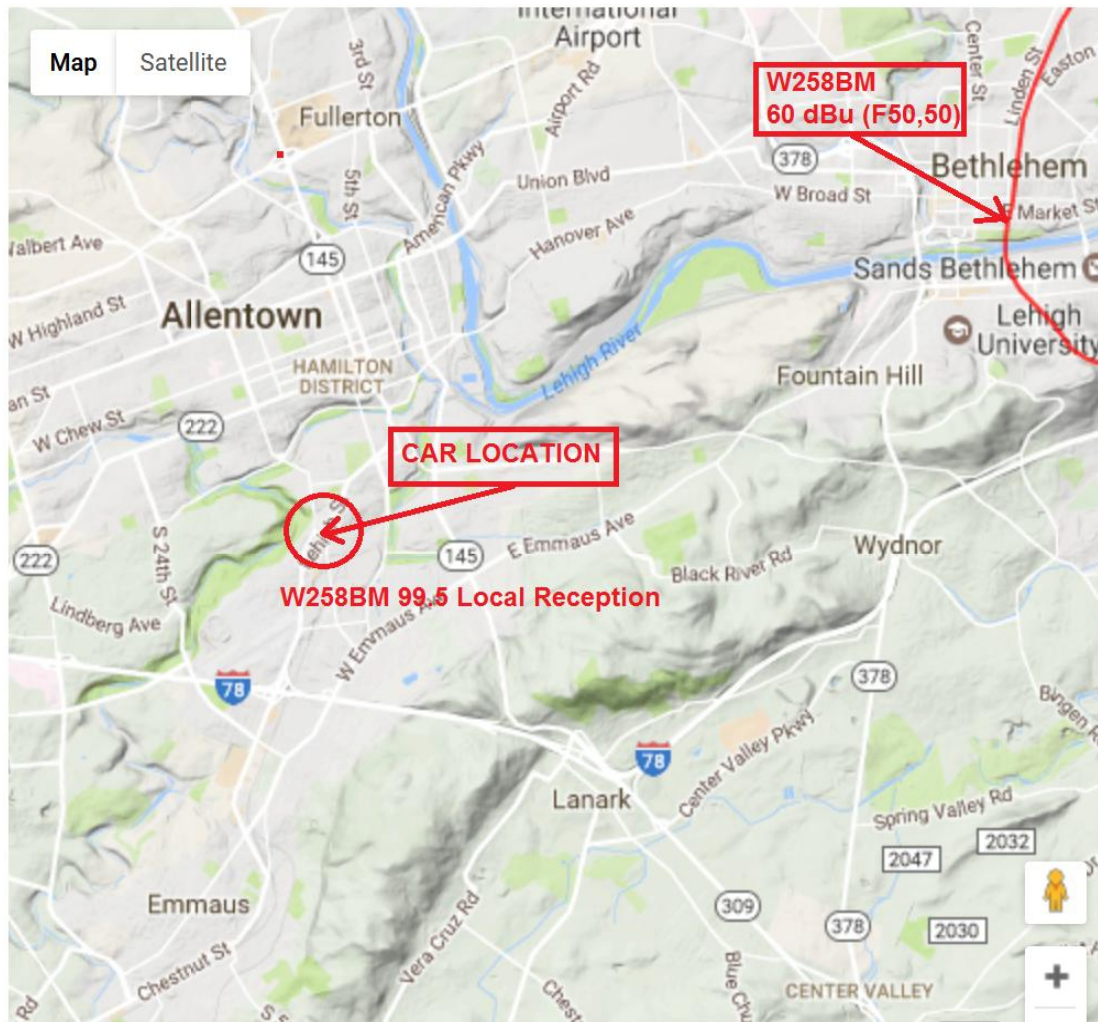


## Lehigh Street

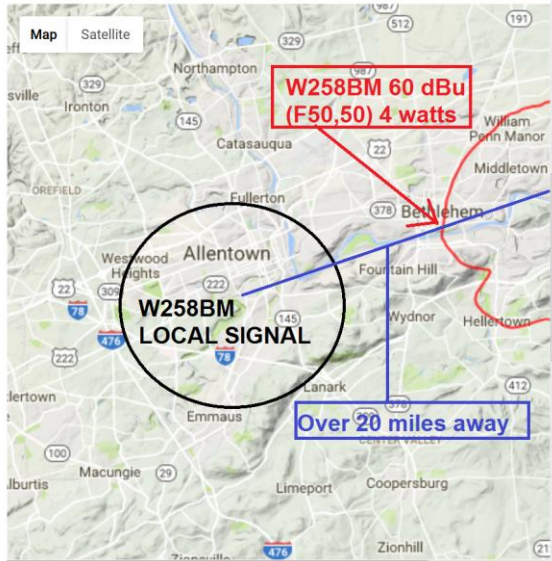
Lehigh Street, Allentown, PA

Signal demonstration for this location is provided in the Video 1, attached to this Documentation. And Sharon ask to FCC run an official investigation and determinate about this.

In the below Picture is same location as above in this you can see the 60 dBu (F50,50) for W258BM Local signal but can be heard locally in Car location over 20 miles away from the tower site of the transmitter for W258BM.



Radio Sharon asks to FCC to investigate this issue and implement the rules to address this type of problem.



W258BM 60 dBu in the past did not reach Allentown City and it was weak, From February until today W258BM signal is crystal clear heard in Allentown.

Probably W258BM increase its power from 4 watts permitted to more watts violating the rules.

Radio Sharon Broadcasting, LLC. Ask to FCC to run an Investigation over W258BM power.

Taking a simple look into the coverage for W258BM, by the strong coverage in Allentown even when the signal is for Easton and the transmitter site is located at 4105 Sherry Hill Rd. Lower Saucon Twp, PA. it is more than 20 miles away.

Since W258BM signal is too strong in Allentown City, PA, Radio Sharon has concluded that there are only 2 reasons that make this possible:

1.- WHOL is using another transmitter located in Allentown City for W258BM 99.5 Transmitter.

OR

2.- WHOL is using more than 4 watts in its location at 4105 Sherry Hill Rd Lower Saucon Twp, PA. for W258BM.

Also W258BM 99.5 can be heard crystal clear at 845 W. Wyoming St. Allentown, PA. 18103 trespassing in our Concrete Building we have a Video attached to support this. In January 99.5 was not heard here with 4 watts from couple months ago they increase the radiate power.

We need that FCC Official in charge for this area take a look into it and investigate the situation, since we are making big investment and required an Equal Opportunity in competition regarding the airwaves and every broadcaster work under the rules.
